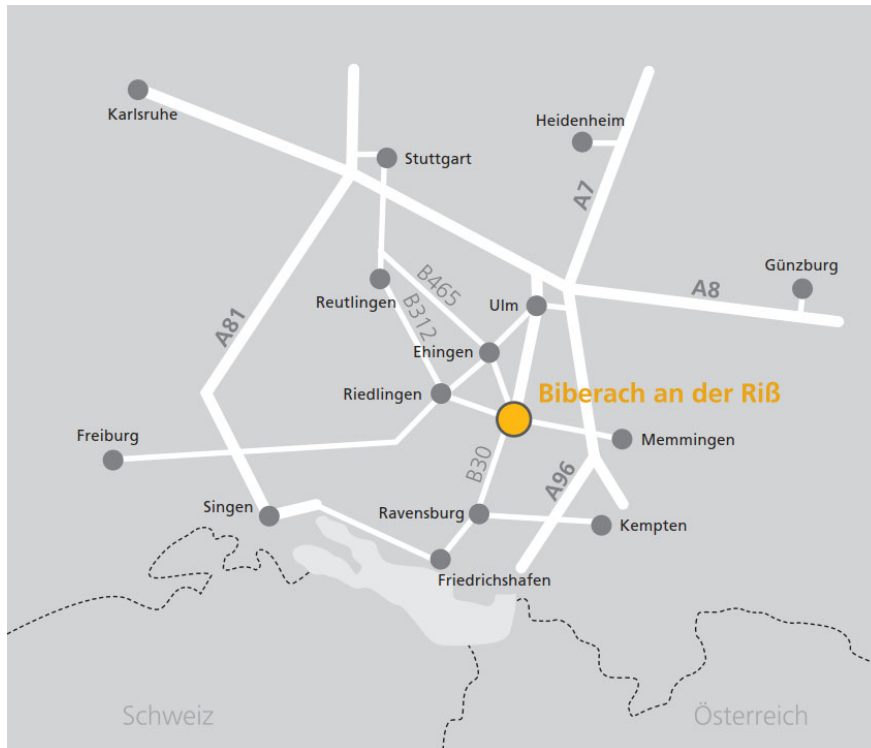

### How to find us

The song "Auf der schwäb'sche Eisenbahn" made Biberach very well known in terms of its transport connections. For 150 years, Biberach has been located on the railway line between Ulm and Lake Constance. Biberach is not only easy to reach by train, but also by car, and the airports of Stuttgart, Memmingen and Friedrichshafen are not far away.



### By car

Biberach itself lies at B30, which is well developed from Ulm.

If you are coming from north, it is best to take A8 or A7 to Ulm and then B30 to Biberach.

Coming from south, you can also leave A7 at the Berkheim junction and reach us via B312.

Parking is possible in the parking lots of the accommodation or at the university. If you park at the university, you will need a parking permit, which you can get from me.

### By train

The nearest long-distance railway station is Ulm on the Stuttgart-Munich route. From here, trains run every half hour to Biberach.

To all who come to us by train via Friedrichshafen and Ravensburg:

At the beginning of March 2020, it is possible that this line will be closed due to electrification work and a rail replacement service with buses will be set up. This could lead to delays.

### By airplane

Nearest airports are Friedrichshafen (FDH), Memmingen (FMM) and Stuttgart (STR).

Biberach can be easily reached by train from any of these airports.

From Friedrichshafen in 1 hour (please check for rail replacement service (see by train))

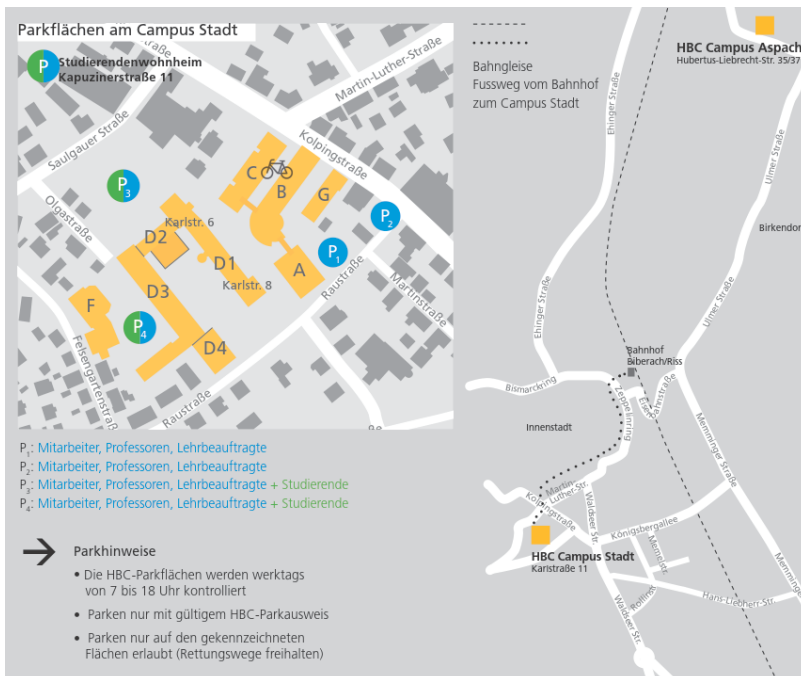
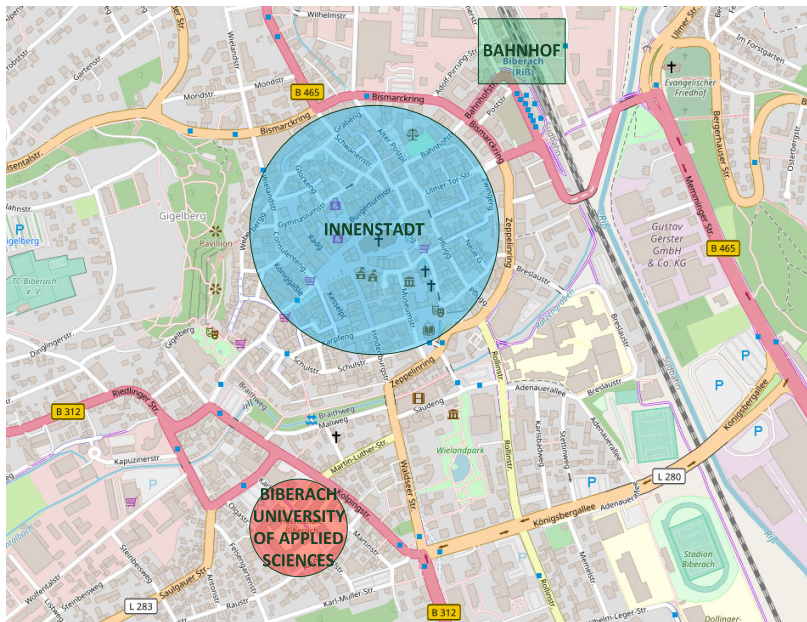
From Memmingen via Ulm in 1.5 hours

## Location of HBC Campus City

The university is located on the edge of the city centre (ca. 750m).

The distance from the university to the railway station is about 1 km.
